Parent Academy provides a safe, supportive, and fun environment for teen parents to learn, grow, and connect. Designed for students attending high school, this program offers:

- Mentorship and encouragement from caring staff
- Pregnancy and parenting education curriculum
- Life skills and resource guidance to support a healthy, successful future
- Material assistance including diapers, wipes, and baby essentials
- Social services and case management to connect families with community resources

Classes are held every other week, lasting 45–60 minutes, and include breakfast or lunch depending on the time of day. We are flexible and can work around the school's schedule to best serve students. A small, private space is needed to meet for class and or individually with students for one-on-one support and case management.
